



Breast cancer in men is rare, occurring much less often than breast cancer in women.

## RISK FACTORS FOR BREAST CANCER IN MEN






Family history of breast cancer

Breast cell growth - normal and abnormal - is stimulated by the presence of estrogen. Men can have high estrogen levels as a result of the conditions below.








Liver cirrhosis

Men diagnosed with male breast cancer at an early stage have a good chance for a cure. Your doctor may conduct a number of diagnostic tests and procedures, such as:


